

Crosses & Losses

Finished Quilt: 76" x 96" - Finished Block Size: 5" x 5"

"Liz's Mercantile" fabric by Sullivan's Fabrics



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Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabrics.

Fabric A: 1 yard black button weed print (#59407)

Fabric B: 3/4 yard cream/tan wreath print (#59340)

Fabric C: 1 yard green bouquet print (#59430)

Fabric D: 3/4 yard cream star print (#59435)

Fabric E: 1 yard red wreath print (#59343)

Fabric F: 3/4 yard tan button weed print (#59402)

Fabric G: 1 yard blue wreath print (#59344)

Fabric H: 3/4 yard cream button weed print (#59406)

Fabric I: 1 yard black bouquet print (#59428)

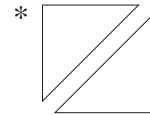
Fabric J: 3/4 yard gold bouquet print (#59432)

Inner Border/Binding: 1-1/3 yards (#59343 red wreath print suggested)

Outer Border: 1-5/8 yards (#59428 black bouquet print suggested)

Backing: 6 yards (#59432 gold flower bouquet print suggested)

84" x 104" quilt batting



Cutting Directions: A 1/4" seam allowance is included in all measurements.

From Fabrics A and E cut:

Two 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into eight 5-7/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

Two 3-3/8" x 44" strips then recut into twenty-four 3-3/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

Four 3" x 44" strips then recut into forty-eight 3" squares

From Fabrics B and F cut:

Two 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into eight 5-7/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

Two 3-3/8" x 44" strips then recut into twenty-four 3-3/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

From Fabric C cut:

Two 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into twelve 5-7/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

Two 3-3/8" x 44" strips then recut into sixteen 3-3/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

Three 3" x 44" strips then recut into thirty-two 3" squares

From Fabric D cut:

Two 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into twelve 5-7/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

Two 3-3/8" x 44" strips then recut into sixteen 3-3/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

From Fabrics G and I cut:

Two 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into ten 5-7/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

Two 3-3/8" x 44" strips then recut into sixteen 3-3/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

Three 3" x 44" strips then recut into thirty-two 3" squares

From Fabrics H and J cut:

Two 5-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into ten 5-7/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

Two 3-3/8" x 44" strips then recut into sixteen 3-3/8" squares (*each cut in half diagonally)

From Inner Border/Binding Fabric cut:

Seventeen 2-1/2" x 44" strips

From Outer Border Fabric cut:

Eight 6-1/2" x 44" strips

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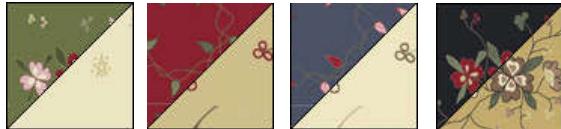
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Half-Square Triangle Blocks:

1. Sew a Fabric A 5-7/8" half-square triangle to a Fabric B 5-7/8" half-square triangle. Make a total of sixteen A/B large triangle sets.



Also make the following large triangle sets:



24 C/D 16 E/F 20 G/H 20 I/J.

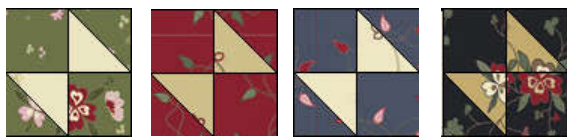
Four-Patch Blocks

1. Using the 3-3/8" half-square triangles make the following small triangle sets:



48 A/B 32 C/D 48 E/F 32 G/H 32 I/J.

2. Use two small A/B triangle sets from Step #2 and two Fabric A 3" squares to make a four-patch unit. Make a total of twenty-four A/B four-patch units. Make the following four-patch units using the 3" squares of the same dark fabric as the triangle sets:



16 C/D 24 E/F 16 G/H 16 I/J.

Assembly Directions.

1. Lay out the blocks in sixteen rows of twelve blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks into rows. Sew rows together.

2. Make four Inner Border strips each with two 2-1/2" x 44" strips sewn together end-to-end. Add borders to the right and left sides of quilt. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions. Add remaining borders to top and bottom of quilt.

3. Make four Outer Border strips each with two 6-1/2" x 44" strips sewn together end-to-end. Add borders to right and left sides then to the top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing Directions:

1. Cut backing fabric into two equal lengths. Sew halves together along the selvage edges.

2. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste. Quilt as desired.

3. Sew nine 2-1/2" binding strips together end-to-end. Press in half lengthwise, right sides out.

4. Trim excess batting and backing even with quilt top.

5. Apply binding to top of quilt. Turn and hand stitch to back of quilt.
