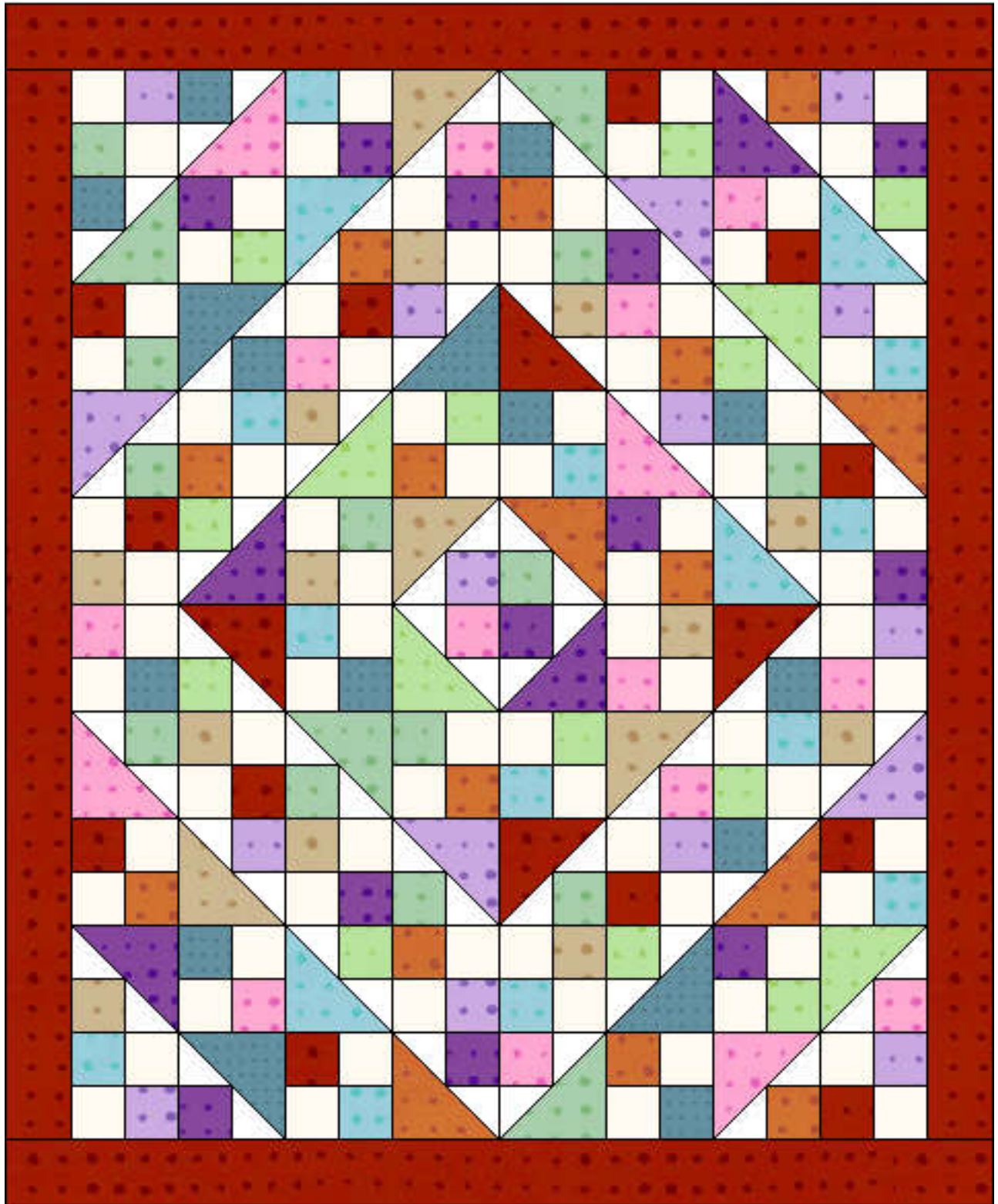


Jeweled Dots

Finished Quilt: 74" x 90" - Finished Block Size: 8" x 8"

"Hot Dots" fabric by Sullivan's Fabrics



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Fabric Requirements: Based on 44" wide fabrics

2 yards **white-on-white** fabric

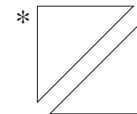
1/2 yard of **ten assorted colored fabrics**

(green, lt. blue, lt. green, lt. purple, orange, pink, purple, red, tan and teal)

2 yards border/binding fabric (red was used in sample quilt)

5-1/4 yards backing fabric (lt. blue dots suggested)

80" x 96" quilt batting



Cutting Directions: A 1/4" seam allowance is included in all measurements.

From the **white-on-white** fabric:

Cut five 4-7/8" x 44" strips then recut into forty 4-7/8" squares, cut each in half diagonally*

Cut nine 4-1/2" x 44" strips then recut into eighty 4-1/2" squares

From *each* of the **ten assorted colored fabrics**:

Cut one 8-7/8" x 44" strip then recut into two 8-7/8" squares and four 4-1/2" squares

Cut each of the 8-7/8" squares in half diagonally once*

Cut one 4-1/2" x 44" strip then recut into eight 4-1/2" squares

From the **border/binding** fabric:

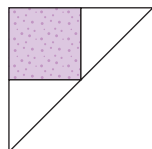
Cut eight 5-1/2" x 44" strips for border *and* nine 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Sewing Directions:

Use the colored squares randomly when sewing.

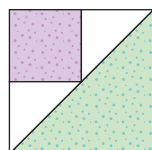
Block 1:

1. Sew two 4-7/8" half-square white triangles to a 3-1/2" colored square. Make a total of forty units.



2. Stitch an 8-7/8" half-square colored triangle to each square/triangle units.

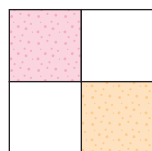
Make forty **Block 1**.



Block 2:

1. Lay out two 4-1/2" white and two colored prints as shown.

2. Sew squares into rows. Sew rows together. Make forty **Block 2**.



Assembly Directions.

1. Lay out the blocks in ten rows of eight blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks into rows. Sew rows together.

2. Make four borders each with two 5-1/2" x 44" border fabric strips sewn together end-to-end. Add borders to right and left sides of quilt. Press and trim excess. Add top and bottom border in the same manner.

Finishing Directions:

1. Cut backing fabric into two equal lengths. Sew halves together along the selvage edges.

2. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste. Quilt as desired.

3. Sew 2-1/2" binding strips together end-to-end. Press in half lengthwise, right sides out.

4. Trim excess batting and backing even with quilt top.

5. Apply binding to top of quilt. Turn and hand stitch to back of quilt.
