You Will Need

Wreath

- 1 Decofoam Wreath Item: 49052
- Silver Cord (20cm Piece To Hang) Item: 47271
- White With Silver Marabou Item: 70248
- Pair Of Craft Scissors Item: 15009
- Glue Gun Item: 48484
- Glue Sticks Item: 48394

Sprays

- Silver Glitter Item: 88531
- Silver Glitter Card Item: 50632
- Silver Foil Card Item: 49987
- Decofoam Balls 20mm Item: 49062
- Decofoam Balls 38mm Item: 49061
- PVA Glue Item: 50017
- Holly Templates (Provided)
- Paint Brush
- Bowl For Glitter
- Food Skewer
- Plate For Glue



Wreath Instructions



1. To simplify the process take the marabou off the card and put into a large snappy bag. Close the bag 2/3's of the way so marabou can feed out of the hole.
2. Attach the end to the back of your decofoam wreath with hot glue.
3. Now wrap it around the wreath until it is covered (feeding the bag through is much simpler and cleaner process).

4. When finished cut off any excess and anchor the end to the back with hot glue.

Spray Instructions



1. Using the Holly templates provided, turn your card stock over and trace around your templates. How many you cut out depends on how big or small you want to make your sprays. You have enough card stock to make a large spray for the top and a small spray for the bottom as per our images.

2. Cut out your leaves and play with your layout until you are happy with it.

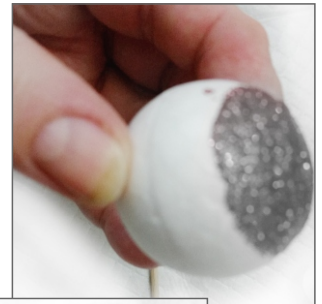


3. Put glitter into a bowl.

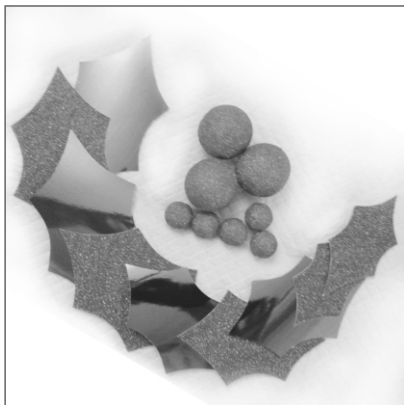
4. Pour some PVA glue into a plate.

5. Glitter all balls: brush on some glue on bottom of ball and dip into glitter.

6. Stick the skewer into the middle of glittered part. Using skewer as a handle to make your glittering a tidier experience, brush glue onto rest of ball then dip into glitter until evenly covered. Set aside to dry.



7. Once your balls are dry you can then hot glue the balls to the spray of leaves.
